## NOTES FROM THE CEO

As I write this, it is mid March 2010; and we are heavily engaged in planning our annual Golf Scramble, Will Golf for Food campaign, “Ladies Nite Out” Fundraiser as well as completing grant proposals. We’ve added a new program called “ChangePoint”. Ian Robertson is heading up this new area of work for us. He and his team are working on panhandling alternatives, career counseling, and several other initiatives. We are also negotiating with some dentists to open a new practice here geared toward lower income families. With so much happening, it is a challenge to reflect on the past year; SVP is a decidedly “forward thinking” organization.

However, in every respect, 2009 was a significant year for us. We finished our much needed Food Bank expansion project (and fully paid for it). Our fundraising was up by 12% in an economy where most charities fell considerably short of their goals. Yet, despite our success at raising capital dollars, we still experienced an operational loss. With reserves diminished, we had to reorganize our staffing to reduce expenses. Some of this reorganization was made possible through shifting work to two part time staff whose salaries are reimbursed through a Title 5 grant from Aging & Long Term Care. With the economy slowly improving and some new fundraising strategies in place, we are confident that we can “break even” in 2010. Elsewhere in this report you will see stories and statistics; none is more important than this: SVP continues to operate in a highly efficient manner, with a total administrative overhead of less than 6%, and we continue to turn every dollar donated into six dollars in services... an outstanding return on these social investments. We thank each of you for the trust you place in us and the confidence you have in our programs.

## WHERE ARE WE GOING?

The food warehouse is complete and operational. As we collect on pledges made, it will be fully paid for. Since September, when it was completed, our warehouse and food bank has served a 13% increase in clients. However, securing the funding for this capital project has had a negative effect on our operating income. Budget shortfalls have necessitated that one staff position remain unfilled and another eliminated. When operating with administrative and fundraising costs at less than 6%, every cutback has a real impact.

The focus for 2010 is to maintain as many programs as possible while securing enough unrestricted revenue to operate with a balanced budget. We can do this by maximizing our special events. With full sponsorships for both golf and Ladies Night Out, a complete 36 team field for golf, and at least 300 attendees at LNO we can achieve this goal. We welcome help with either or both events and rely even more on the generosity of our supporters. If every one of our donors makes one extra donation this year and shares a donation envelope with a neighbor, SVP has a real opportunity to finish 2010 with a balanced budget.

## SPOKANE VALLEY PARTNERS FOOD BANK

SVP Food Bank provides up to 4 days of emergency food to low income households and those experiencing emergencies. Additionally they distribute The Emergency Food Assistance Program (T. E. F. A. P.) commodities from the State and Federal Government, along with the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (C. S. F. P.). Our suppliers are Second Harvest, Northwest Harvest, Dollar Trees, local food drives, and “plant-a-row” gardeners.

Cooking and nutrition classes are offered on Wednesdays. From September through December of 2009 usage increased 13%.

## Spokane Valley Partners Clothing Bank

The clothing bank is 100% run by volunteers and primarily supported by volunteer donations. Clients can visit two times a month. They receive items and amounts based on their family size.

## Spokane Valley Partners Protective Payee

This program helps Washington State DSHS referred clients and Social Security (SSI) referred clients to manage their low fixed incomes. Clients' key bills are paid and a living allowance is distributed to the clients.

Our emergency assistance case manager helps those in need by smoothing out life's bumps in the road. Some problems are handled solely by SVP. SVP also collaborates with other agencies to better meet the client's needs and makes referrals to other community resources if necessary.

## HOW WE HELPED AMBER

In order to provide the best services, we conduct surveys and undergo audits of our programs on a regular basis. These activities generate statistics that allow us to evaluate our effectiveness. Sometimes though, we simply ask folks about their experiences at SVP.

A young lady, we'll call her Amber, came to us about 15 months ago for Representative Payee Services. Amber had recently moved here from California where she also had a payee. To say Amber was surprised when she came to SVP is an understatement. She told us that the service she received from her former payee was perfunctory, with no counseling or referral to other needed resources. Here, she is pleased to receive not only in-depth case management, but also, supplementary food and nutrition classes, basic necessities from our clothing bank and school supplies. She needed a one time energy grant; and was able to receive that at our SNAP Office. She is now receiving help through our WIC Clinic as well. Amber is also going to be attending financial education classes through SNAP Financial Access here at our campus. She said she likes being treated with respect, and as a person, not just a case number. Amber also feels that she is well on her way to a more prosperous and independent future because of the assistance provided by SVP...exactly why we are here.

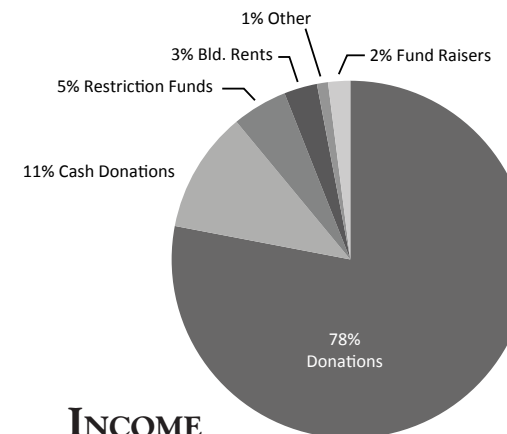

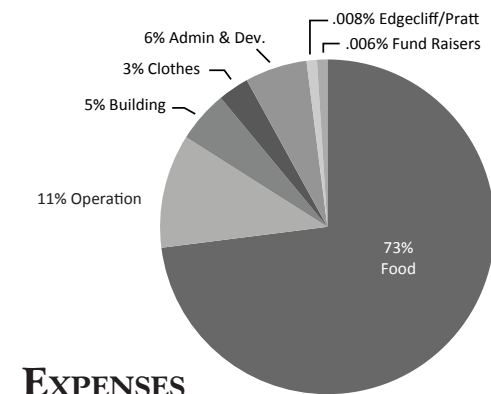
