## **Doing Good is Good for Business.**


Through the help of local businesses and corporations, we can help our neighbors thrive today and build brighter futures tomorrow by addressing hunger and poverty.



# WHAT WE DO

*Prevent hunger and poverty alongside great community partners*

## **FOOD BANK**

*Spokane Valley Partners Food Bank provides over 1,000 tons of groceries each year to over 9,000 families and neighbors in need. Through food rescue, individual donations, and partnerships with Second Harvest and Northwest Harvest we are able to meet the needs of the community we serve.*

## **INLAND NORTHWEST DIAPER BANK**

*One out of 3 families struggle to buy diapers for their children. The Inland Northwest Diaper Bank is here to assist community agencies serving those families through Eastern Washington. Agencies throughout the region receive 10,000 diapers monthly from our program to support their missions.*

## **FOOD FOR THOUGHT**

*In Spokane County 1 in 5 children live in households that don't have enough food for every family member to lead a healthy life. This food insecurity threatens a child's well-being and potential for success. Food For Thought provides weekend meals for nearly 500 students each week to help improve school performance, academic success and cognitive development.*

## **CLOTHING BANK**

*As the region's largest clothing bank Spokane Valley Partners provides over 50,000 pounds of clothing to nearly 5,000 families. Essential household needs such as cleaning supplies, hygiene products, diapers and other small household items are also accepted and distributed to those in need.*

## **EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE**

*Spokane Valley Partners provides emergency utility assistance for people with no place left to turn. In partnership with Avista, Modern Electric and Vera Spokane Valley Partners is able to provide financial assistance for utilities to residents in the Spokane Valley. Additional assistance is also provided to seniors with needs including prescriptions and medical equipment.*

## **PROTECTIVE PAYEE SERVICES**

*Our Protective Payee program assists those not fully capable of managing their own Social Security or DSHS benefits. Our financial counselor works with clients to ensure security in housing, food, and medical needs. Through financial management, and protection from financial abuse and victimization clients achieve greater financial stability and independence.*

### BECAUSE OF YOU

Spokane Valley Partners relies on the generosity of its supporters and corporate partners to help fight hunger in our community. We incur less than 8 percent administrative and fundraising costs annually. This means that, of every dollar raised, more than 92 cents goes toward programs and services for neighbors in need.



**8,966**

8,966 families were served through our food bank. In addition, more than 500 students are served every week through our Food For Thought Program.



**99,986**

99,986 diapers were distributed this year to partner agencies to support families served through their missions throughout Eastern Washington.



**2,088,682**

2 million pounds of food were distributed to neighbors in need. 400,000 pounds of which, were rescued from area grocers and restaurants.


